1990 brings the release of more new products from Alvey's high tech injection moulding section of their Brisbane factory.

At last now, junior and casual anglers can buy a reel that is not expensive ~~to buy~~ but has all the normal features of an Alvey reel, ~~but~~ made from fibre glass reinforced nylon.

This beaut little 4" reel (Model 40B) can be used for right hand or left hand wind, has non reverse wind action and it's totally salt water resistant.

These reels come in a range of colours, skin packed in boxes of 6 units or loose in boxes of 10.

The Alvey Fishing Kit incorporates the 40B reel with a 5ft. ( 2 pce solid glass rod, small bait bucket, spool of line, hookdisgorger, scaler and a printed guide to Australian fishing leaflet filled with lots of valuable fishing tips.

60A&C model reels are ~~now~~ available with the full size back plate, making them a very useable reel now for boat or beach fishing where you need that little bit extra recovery rate, but still want a light weight reel.

A new moulded Rod Bucket in two styles, wide for beach fishing and gimble for boat fishing, has just been released on the market.

It is moulded from a synthetic rubber material which is both strong and has high UV stability, yet it is soft and flexible enough to make the rod bucket very comfortable to wear.

A large range of top quality Zebco Quantum spinning reels will be on display as well as many of the famous Zebco closed face reels made in the USA. which are experiencing a resurgence in popularity throughout Australia.

Quantum Saltwater Series reels with bait sensor, stainless steel gears will be shown with reels like the Zebco 33 Classic closed face which holds 100yards/10lb line, has stainless steel ball bearings, smooth clutch non corrosive frame and is an ideal alternate to an overhead reel but much more simple to use.

Zebco 606 reel holds 80yards 8lb line and has a power lever drag control as well as a dial "fine" control. Double winding handles, strong helical gears silent non reverse are all featured on the great little reel.

Australian Monofilament Company will have their full range of Platypus, Pretest and Monoflex lines on display. These come in a wide range of diameters and sizes of spools up to 3KG weight.

Some heavy grades of Monoflex come in hanks which are ideal for professional fishermen.

All grades of line including weedeater line are manufactured in the companys high tech plant in Brisbane.

A large range of the rods and blanks made in Australia by Snyder Glas will be shown. The range covers from pistol grip spinning rods to heavy surf and rock fishing rods.

New at the show will be the "Mag Bream" white tip rod. It is approximately 136" in length with the latest Fuji high set V frame BSVLG guides and graphite reel seat.

The blank is made out of a high pressure polyester E glass and high modulus graphite combined to make an ideal, whiting, bream, flathead, dart etc. rod.

This rod compliments the present Mag. Surf White Tip - Surf rod, so the discerning angler can now have a "pigeon" pair of the latest in technology - Mag. Surf White Tip Rod and Mag. Bream White Tip Rod.

Also there will be a new range of graphite composite game blanks and some samples of the new style galss to galss ferrule on standard blanks.
